CONNECTICUT PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
CONNECTICUT URBANIZED AREAS**

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 13b-11a, subsection (b) of the Statutes of the State of Connecticut, a public hearing will be held on Tuesday June 20 at **7:30 p.m.** in the Aldermanic Chambers at the Derby Town Hall.

Issues of interest include:

- Continued funding for Paratransit/Dial-a-Ride operations;*
- Service improvements Waterbury Branch of Metro-North;*
- Adequacy of Jobs Access transportation services;*
- Other topics of interest to the public.*

This is one of a series of four public hearings, which will be held this spring throughout the state in metropolitan areas designated by the Connecticut Public Transportation Commission (CPTC). These hearings will enable members of the CPTC to gain firsthand information and reactions from the public concerning existing and proposed public transportation services within the State of Connecticut. The CPTC is particularly interested in receiving comments from public officials and private citizens on how public transportation is working in the state and what might be done to improve it.
